Longmont Red Lobster gets upgrade

Longmont's Red Lobster restaurant is one of 10 in the Denver metro area that has been remodeled or constructed to represent the company's "Bar Harbor" style, meant to be reminiscent of the seaside village of Bar Harbor, Maine.

The new look features stone towers and Adirondack benches outside and softer, warmer lighting and nautical decor inside.

The company said it plans to have all 700 of its restaurants across the U.S. and Canada remodeled by 2014. Red Lobster has also added new menu items as part of its remodel.

The Longmont restaurant, which opened in May 2000, is at 2177 Ken Pratt Blvd.
